Recycling Drop-off Site

The City of Ripon, Ripon Unified School District and Recology Recycling has designed a recycling program to benefit Ripon's Elementary Schools and the Parent Faculty Clubs (PFC).

ITEMS ACCEPTED: cardboard, newspaper, aluminum cans, plastic bottles, Styrofoam #6, glass & plastic containers.

ELECTRONIC WASTE: You may drop off electronic waste in the designated area. Items include televisions, radios, copiers, phones, computers, monitors & printers. **Household batteries** must be dropped off at City Hall, the Library, or the Police Department.
