15.02.010 Adopted.

The 1994 Edition of the Uniform Administrative Code, including Tables No. 3-A to and including 3-H setting forth the fees to be charged for various types of permits published by the International Conference of Building Officials, a copy of which is now on file and open to inspection by the public in the Office of the City Clerk and in addition, in the Office of the Building Official, is adopted by incorporation in this chapter as the Administrative Code of the City pursuant to the provisions of the Government Code of the State of California relating thereto, and each and every provision therein set forth, except as amended by this chapter and the amendments thereto set forth in this chapter, are enacted as a part thereof. 15.02.020 Violation - Penalty.

A. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of the code shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars, or by imprisonment in the City Jail or in the County Jail for a period not to exceed ninety days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

B. Each separate day or any portion thereof during which any violation of the code is continued shall be deemed to constitute a separate offense, and upon conviction thereof shall be punishable as provided in this chapter.

C. The issuance or granting of a permit or approval of plans and specifications for any work shall not be deemed or construed to be a permit for, or an approval of, any violation of any of the provisions of this code. No permit presuming to give authority to violate or cancel any of the provisions of this code shall be valid, except insofar as the work or use which it authorized is valid.
