The 1986 edition of the Uniform Code for Solar Energy Installations, including Appendix A, three copies of which are now on file in the office of the building inspector of the city, is adopted by incorporation in this chapter as the Uniform Code for Solar Energy Installations of the city pursuant to the provisions of the Government Code of the state relating thereto, and each and every provision therein set forth except as amended in this chapter is referred to and made a part of this chapter as fully as if set forth in this chapter, and the amendments thereto set forth in this chapter are enacted as part thereof. 15.24.040 Violation—Penalty.

Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this code shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars, or by imprisonment in the City Jail, or in the County Jail for a period not to exceed ninety days, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Each separate day or any portion thereof during which any violation of this code is continued shall be deemed to constitute a separate offense and upon conviction thereof shall be punishable as provided in this chapter. The issuance or granting of a permit or approval of plans and specification shall not be deemed or construed to be a permit for, or an approval of, any violation of any of the provisions of this code. No permit presuming to give authority to violate or cancel the provisions of this code shall be valid, except insofar as the work or use which it authorized is lawful.
