2.28.010 Intent to receive aid.

The city declares that it desires to qualify to receive aid from the state of California under the provisions of Section 13522, Chapter 1, of Title 4, Part 4 of the California Penal Code. (Ord. 471 § 1, 1991)

2.28.020 Adherence to standards.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 13510(c), Chapter 1, the city will adhere to standards for recruitment and training as established by the California Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training. (Ord. 471 § 2, 1991)

2.28.030 Enforcement.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 13512, Chapter 1, the California Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training and its representatives may make such inquiries as deemed appropriate by the Commission to ascertain that the city's public safety dispatchers adhere to standards for selection and training as established by the commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training.
