Service for each can must be retained for one year from the date can is delivered.

To help us serve you better please comply with the following instructions. **If compliance is not met with the City of Ripon regulations below, it may cause a non service which will reflect a "Go Back" charge.**

- Cans are to be at least **5 feet** from any obstruction including other cans, fences, poles, vehicles, basketball hoops, etc.
- No articles more than 2 feet in length and 2 inches in diameter in can.
- Cans must be on the street with wheels against the curb.
- DO NOT** over fill cans. Lids **MUST** be closed for proper dumping. **Note:** *Overfilled cans are subject to a non service which will reflect a "Go back" charge.*
- All refuse must be placed in the can. Any garbage left on the street will not be dumped.
- Cans are to be used for household refuse only, **NOT** construction waste.
- Cans must be out at curbside by 6:00 a.m. If not, there may be a "Go Back" charge.**
- Cans need to be placed at curbside no sooner than the evening before the pickup day.
- All empty cans must be removed from curbside by the evening of the pickup day.

It is your responsibility to have can(s) accessible to ensure pick up.

DO NOT PUT THE FOLLOWING INTO CANS:

- Cement or Concrete	- Volatile Liquids	- Rocks
- Heavy Materials	- Paint	- Dirt/Sod
- Hazardous Waste	- Oil	- Gas
- Televisions/Computer Monitors	- Chemicals	- Hot Coals
- Any items containing Freon	- Stumps	- Patio Umbrellas

FAILURE TO COMPLY MAY BE CAUSE FOR A CITATION. ALL OF THE ABOVE PERTAINS TO RESIDENTIAL CANS.
